5. All entry forms must be received by 5pm on Thursday 25th September 2025.
6. Staging of entries Friday 26th September 6 - 7pm and on Saturday 27th September 8:30 - 10am.
7. All exhibitors must leave the hall by 10am at the latest.
8. The entries must remain until 4pm.
9. Unless otherwise stated, all entries must be the work of / grown by the exhibitor.
10. All entries are staged at the owner's risk.
11. We only accept entries from Ampleforth & District residents.
12. We accept no responsibility for any loss or damage to entries.
13. Any objections must be made in writing to the Ampleforth & District Gardening Club Committee no later than 2.45pm on the show day.
14. Numbers will be supplied by the Entries Secretary when you deliver your entries.
15. Each person will be responsible for the correct numbering of their entries.
16. Any entries requiring a plate, are to be on plain, white plates.
17. A point system will operate in each class. First - 3 points, Second - 2 points, Third - 1 point. The most points in each class will receive an award. The most points overall from all classes will win a special award.
18. The Committee reserves the right to reject any entries which do not conform to the rules or is regarded unsuitable for the class entered.
